

There is a total of \$174,800 for the Superior Watershed Partnership over three years. This is 5.3% of the total budget (\$41,600 per year). The grant requires SWP field biologists/scientists to conduct before/after monitoring, provide public education, coordinate habitat restoration contractors, grant administration, etc.

There is also \$64,000 for the Great Lakes Conservation Corps (GLCC) to assist with habitat restoration, native plantings, etc. The GLCC employs young adults (18-25 years old) and are far more efficient and cost effective than consultants/contractors.

The majority of the grant (over \$2.3 Million) is for contractual, engineering, construction contractors, etc.
