WHEREAS, the Commission recognizes that reliable, high-speed, affordable
access to the internet is imperative for Marquette area residents, businesses, non-profits, and
visitors, as well as a driving force for the current and future economy; and
WHEREAS, municipalities are increasingly prioritizing internet infrastructure as an
essential service, along with other utilities such as electricity; and
WHEREAS, the Board of Light and Power of the City of Marquette (the "MBLP")
has invested in a feasibility study to explore the potential benefit and financial viability of
offering fiber-to-the-premises (FTTP) broadband internet service to its customers inside and
outside the City of Marquette; and
WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Marquette places all municipal utilities under
control of the City except the "electric light and power utilities", which it reserves to the
control of the MBLP; and
WHEREAS, the City recognizes that the MBLP, as a municipal electric company,
is uniquely suited to offer broadband internet service due to the overlap in infrastructure

WHEREAS, the City does not intend to offer broadband internet service as a utility

required to provide electric and fiber optic internet services, as well as MBLP's existing

"fiber loop" which has existed approximately 15 years in the City; and

and agrees the MBLP is best positioned to offer and control broadband internet service, should the MBLP decide to offer it as a utility in addition to electrical service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION, as follows:

- 1. The City supports the MBLP's exploration of broadband internet service as a potential additional utility in the City to be offered and controlled by the MBLP.
- 2. The City welcomes any future requests by the MBLP to adapt City ordinances and, if necessary, the Charter, to facilitate the offering of broadband internet service as an additional municipal utility by the MBLP.
