As noted, this task force should, at a minimum, include representation from both the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and the Traffic-Parking Advisory Committee, and should be tasked with gathering and compiling information from a broad range of community stakeholders. Over a defined period during the summer, the task force could publicly solicit input from citizens, trail users, local businesses, advocacy groups, and other interested parties.

Ultimately, the group would provide the City Commission with a summary of the information gathered. This final report may include specific policy recommendations or present a range of potential regulatory and programmatic options for consideration.
